RE: CITY OF REDONDO BEACH SUPPORTS GREEN LINE EXTENSION

As Mayor, and on behalf of the City Council of the City of Redondo Beach, I wish to make you aware that the City of Redondo Beach is in support of extending the Green Line south of Marine Avenue to the South Bay Galleria. On November 14, 2006 the City Council of the City of Redondo Beach adopted a position in support of the Green Line extension and requested the South Bay Cities Council of Governments Board of Directors to support a southern extension of the Green Line.

The City of Redondo Beach requests that the SBCCOG take the following action:

- 1) request the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority to include a southern extension of the Green Line to the Galleria in conjunction with any plans to extend the Green Line to Los Angeles International Airport, and
- 2) request that the MTA include a southern extension of the Green Line in the current update of the Long Range Transportation Plan.

We hope that with the support of the South Bay Cities Council of Governments, the MTA will consider the Green Line extension a high priority and initiate studies to determine the most appropriate alignment for the extension.

The City of Redondo Beach appreciates the importance of this issue to the South Bay cities and we look forward to working together with the SBCCOG on this and other transportation issues important to the South Bay.
