

**Report on KHHR Communities Network Committee of
October 17, 2019**

Here are the highlights of the above KHHR Communities Network Committee “CNC):

- The City of Hawthorne announced that it has received a grant from the FAA to do a Part 150 study, which will determine the location and impact of aircraft noise on the community.
- David Cushing, Manager of the FAA’s Airport District Office, presented a detailed description of what the study will entail. The FAA will prepare a Q and A concerning Part 150 and provide it to the CNC members.
- A representative from Star Helicopters gave an overview of safe helicopter operations. He said there is no restriction for the lower limit of helicopter flights, as long as the flight is not so low as to create undue hazard for people and property on the ground. The regulation that would be enforced for a flight that created that hazard would be Federal Aviation Regulation (FAR) 91.13, operating an aircraft in a careless or reckless manner.
