We understand that the South Bay Cities Council of Governments is willing to provide funding from Measure R South Bay Highway Program in support of the City of Hermosa Beach request from Caltrans to prepare a Project Assessment/Environmental Document (PA/ED) for the PCH/Aviation Mobility Improvements/Complete Streets Project.

The City of Hermosa Beach hereby requests that the South Bay Cities Council of Governments fund using the South Bay Highway Program (SBHP) a PA/ED document to be prepared by Caltrans. The estimated fee amount of \$3,000,000 includes a contingency of approximately \$500,000 in evaluation of border areas within Manhattan Beach on the north and/or Redondo Beach on the south to allow consideration of logical termini designs that will be developed as the project is defined and environmentally cleared in the PA/ED phase.
